ASSOCIATE CLUB MEMBERSHIP



1.1 <u>Rights of Associate Club Members</u>

- 1.1.1 Associate Club Members shall be eligible to participate in competitions and events organized by BAS.
- 1.1.2 Associate Club Members shall have no voting rights and cannot hold office.

1.2 Membership Fees

- 1.2.1 The entrance fee for Associate Club Members shall be SGD 200.
- 1.2.2 The annual subscription fee for Associate Club Members shall be SGD 100.
- 1.2.3 The one-time entrance fee and first annual subscription shall be payable during the application.
- 1.2.4 Subsequent annual subscriptions shall be paid before the end of each financial year (31 March). Any Associate Club Member who fail to abide by this rule shall be deemed to have lost its right to participate in competitions and events organized by BAS. The club will also be deemed to have lost its rights to all their registered players. The club will have to restart the whole application process should it wish to continue being a BAS Associate Club Member.
- 1.2.5 All fees paid shall be non-refundable.
- 1.3 <u>Membership Application Process</u>
 - 1.3.1 Completed application form shall be submitted to BAS office, together with the payment of one-time entrance fee and annual subscription fee.
- 1.4 <u>Club Naming Guidelines</u>
 - 1.4.1 Once a club's registration is approved, there can be no changes to the club's name, unless otherwise approved by BAS.
 - 1.4.2 The club name shall be in English, unless otherwise approved by BAS.
 - 1.4.3 BAS may reject the use of a club name that can be interpreted as vulgar, immoral, political, unethical or controversial.

1.5 <u>Competitions</u>

- 1.5.1 Only registered clubs are allowed to participate in BAS organized competitions and events.
- 1.5.2 During registration into a competition, teams must use the registered club name.
- 1.5.3 Teams are allowed to use a commercial or sponsor's suffix at the end of the team's name during the registration in a competition, up to a maximum of 10 characters. This suffix will not be considered part of the club's name and can be changed every season.
- 1.5.4 For practical reasons, terms such as 'Basketball Club', 'Sports Club', or 'Sports Association' may be omitted from the team name in official publications.
- 1.5.5 Clubs that wish to send multiple teams to one competition must explicitly state their second team by adding a suffix at the end of their second team's name. Colour codes are not encouraged, unless it is generally known and accepted that the colour refers to their second team.
